- Owned & managed by Latter Day Saints
- Family Search has over 2,000 data set collections
- Family Search is the "savior" to many historical records
- Good tool for research, info storage & source citation

- Free to anyone and everyone
- Research tool for vital information; census; immigration & naturalization; military; land, wills & probates
- Accessibility with internet connection
- Great family tree presentation, source documents
- Weaknesses:
 - Free to anyone and everyone
 - Searches are complex
 - Security

Ancestry.com – Rich Functionality

- Subscription-based tool (monthly, annually)
- Good tool for research, info storage & source citation
- Most popular genealogy tool
- Preservation of many historical records
- Web-based available anywhere (smartphone app available)
- Integrated with Newspapers.co & Fold3
- DNA tests and matches available

- Strengths:
 - Hints batch processes that scour databases
 - 60b records available
 - 25m DNA tests
 - Research tool for vital information; census; immigration & naturalization; military; land, wills & probates
 - Accessibility and Smartphone updates & display
 - Rich family tree presentation and fact data
- Weaknesses:
 - Searches can be complex

Family Tree Maker

- PC-based: buy once use forever except updates
- Leverages FamilySearch and Ancestry.com for research (no research capabilities in FTM)
- Bi-directional synchronization with Ancestry.com
- Easy-to-use for Windows/Mac users
- Supports smartphone display of information
- <u>Very</u> rich in reporting capabilities & mass changes

- Strengths:
 - Reporting and mass updates
 - TreeVault backs up incrementally to cloud and supports smartphone access
 - Family tree presentation is excellent through reporting tools
 - Open architecture, i.e. Family Book Creator
 - Security
 - Large user group base
- Weaknesses:
 - No research capabilities requires access to FamilySearch and/or Ancestry.com

New Technologies

- Family Collaboration
- Full-text Searching
- Generative Artificial Intelligence will drive:
 - Data collection by companies like FamilySearch, Ancestry, Gravesite
 - Language Translation
 - Record Searching
